- a. Recreation Director Karnitz gave an update on some current and upcoming programs and events for the Recreation Department
 - i. Flag Football is two weeks into the program with 29 total kids registered. There will be a few scrimmage games scheduled with Horicon and/or Hustisford in the coming weeks. He also stated next year Juneau will be in the league with local communities



- ii. Rage Soccer has had a couple weeks of games so far as they started games September 6th. Games will go until the end of October unless there are any tournaments that teams elect to play in.
- iii. 3-8th Grade EYSBL Girls Basketball has 13 registrations with registration ending Thursday, September 18th. Discussion between Horicon and Hustisford is being had to get enough girls to make teams.
- iv. 3-8th Grade EYSBL Boys Basketball registration and flyers will be open soon once girls have started.
